## INCORPORATING MAPS

- MAPS Policy
  - "It is the policy of the University Clinic to obtain MAPS reports on all new patients, patients requesting controlled substances, patients who are known to be prescribed controlled substances (by this or any clinic), or any patient who is exhibiting erratic or suspicious behavior:"
  - University Clinic MAPS Policy
- Empower Staff
  - "A MAPS report can be pulled by the NP, RN, or PharmD for any of the above scenarios or if the team member has any other reason to suspect that a MAPS report will help with medical decision making."
  - University Clinic MAPS Procedure (Excerpt)

## NOW WHAT?

- Continue prescribing controlled substances to avoid confrontation.
- Refuse to treat the patient.
- Refuse to prescribe controlled substances, but continue to see the patient.
- Refuse to prescribe controlled substances, and recommend substance abuse treatment.
- Prescribe limited amounts of controlled substances as part of a pain contract.

## **PAIN MEDS FOR COUNSELING**

- Be clear
- Follow up
- Follow through

## **CONCLUSIONS**

- MAPS may be cumbersome at first, but offers easy access
- Utilize MAPS universally
- MAPS should guide treatment, not derail it
